

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **What am I earning points towards? Is there a series award or high point?**

A: You are qualifying for a very exciting and rewarding finals. Earn at least four points during the show season and you are eligible for the LEGIS League Finals. You will compete against other qualified finalists in a championship format and win great prizes awarded to the Top Ten!

## **Why join LEGIS League?**

A: Why not?! LEGIS League is a great way to be recognized for your skills and accomplishments in the hunter, jumper, equitation and dressage classes you ride in. Other than the LEGIS League medal finals, there are no additional classes you ride in. If you ride in Children's Hunters, then your points accrue to the LEGIS League Children's Hunter standings. Who doesn't like great competition and fabulous prizes?

## **Where will the finals be held?**

A: In recognition that extensive travel is difficult for many riders, LEGIS League offers finals in various geographic locations. Based on the shows hosting LEGIS League classes for 2019, there will be finals in Northern California and Southern California. Stay tuned for more details, but be sure attend the LEGIS League Finals. You can pick which finals you want to ride in, but you can only ride in one finals show per year.



# Frequently Asked Questions

## **What is an overlay class?**

A: At the LEGIS League Finals, some of the finals are held within an existing special class. For example, the LEGIS League Children's Hunter Finals may be held as part of a regular Children's Hunter Classic. However, the LEGIS League awards will only be given to actual LEGIS League Finals riders.

## **What classes do I need to enter at the finals show to compete in my final?**

A: Look for the LEGIS League Finals page in the prize list. As the Finals get close we will also post explicit information on the LEGIS League website.

## **Does my horse have to be a member?**

A: The rider joins and lists any horses ridden. There is no extra fee for horses. If you get a new horse mid-season, be sure to let us know!

## **How much does it cost?**

A: Membership is only \$30 and runs concurrent with the USEF show season (Dec. 1 to Nov. 30)

## **What kind of prizes are you giving away?**

A: Amazing prizes! Seriously though, we are proud of our prizes. We look for high quality items that we would proud to wear and use. We award useful prizes that you can enjoy, show off, and use. Custom championship jackets, C4 belts, embroidered pads, fabulous vests, cozy pullovers, stall plaques, hats, finalist t-shirts, tote bags, and lovely championship ribbons!



# Frequently Asked Questions

## **Do I have to ride in extra classes?**

A: At regular shows ride in the classes you normally ride in. Any classes that match LEGIS League specifications will be pointed. The only “extra” classes are our LEGIS League medal classes.

## **Can I ride in more than one section?**

A: You can ride in whatever classes you are eligible for.

## **My points disappeared, and now there is just a “Q,” what happened?**

A: Congratulations! You are now qualified for the LEGIS League Finals!

## **Can I qualify at the final show?**

A: Yes, there is usually a last chance to qualify by earning that extra point or two.

## **How do I join?**

A: You can join online on the LEGIS League website, submit a membership form at a show, or mail it to us.

## **My horse show lists jumpers in feet and inches, what classes should I be riding in?**

A: Please see the meter conversion chart.

0.70 m	= Fences 2'3" in height
0.75 m	= Fences 2'5" in height
0.80 m	= Fences 2'7" in height
0.85 m	= Fences 2'9" in height
0.90 m	= Fences 2'11" in height
0.95 m	= Fences 3'1" in height
1.00 m	= Fences 3'3" in height
1.05 m	= Fences 3'5" in height
1.10 m	= Fences 3'7" in height
1.15 m	= Fences 3'9" in height
1.20 m	= Fences 3'11" in height
1.25 m	= Fences 4'1" in height
1.30 m	= Fences 4'3" in height
1.35 m	= Fences 4'5" in height
1.40 m	= Fences 4'7" in height
1.45 m	= Fences 4'9" in height
