



Specifications

LEGIS League hunter/jumper categories are not additional classes, but classes already offered by the competition. LEGIS League member riders receive points based on results in those classes. Riders earn points to qualify for LEGIS League Finals which are held in different locations. Riders must earn at least four points to compete in any LEGIS League Final.

Hunter Sections

Points are earned based on a horse/rider combination.

Junior/Amateur Owner Hunters (3'3"/3'6")

These categories will follow the USHJA Zone specifications of the zone where the show is held.

Children's and Adult Amateur Hunters (3')

These categories will follow the USHJA Zone specifications of the zone where the show is held.

Pony Hunter (Small-2'3"/Medium-2'6"/Large-2'9" or 3')

This category will follow the USHJA Zone specifications of the zone where the horse show is held. May be combined with the Children's Pony Hunters, as warranted by show entries and zone specifications.

Children's/Adult Hunter (2'9")

Open to junior and amateur riders who have not competed in any classes with fences higher than 3'3" in the current competition year.

Low Children's/Adult Hunters (2'6")

These categories will follow the USHJA Zone specifications of the zone where the show is held. To be eligible for the Finals junior and amateur riders may not compete in any classes with fences higher than 3'0" in the current competition year.

Children's Pony Hunter (Small & Medium-2'/Large-2'6")

This category will follow the USHJA Zone specifications of the zone where the horse show is held. May be combined with the Pony Hunter as warranted by show entries and zone specifications.

Demi Hunter Child/Adult 2'3"

Open to junior and amateur riders who have not competed in any classes with fences higher than 2'9" in the current competition year.

Points

Points will be awarded to sixth place in each category as follows: 7-5-4-3-2-1. At least three must compete. Points will be awarded on this scale regardless of the number of entries in the class. In the case of a combined class (i.e.: Children's/Adult Hunter), points will be awarded according to the ribbon won and applied to the rider's age group (Children's or Adult). Any horse shown by a LEGIS League member will accrue points. Riders must earn at least four points to compete in any LEGIS League Final.

Membership

Riders are encouraged to join the LEGIS League prior to competition and may join at the competition for points to count. Once a member joins, points will be retroactive a maximum of 30 days.

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
